We aim to build a love for the game in all our players and be competitive within NSFA and State competitions and seek to develop girls & boys to go on and play Rep football (if they desire).


We measure our success by:-

2) Coaching Philosophy & Approach

The LFC Coaching Philosophy is based on the National Curriculum.

The nationally preferred playing style is defined as being:

- A pro-active brand of football, based on effective possession, with the cutting edge provided by creative individuals.
- Defensively the key components are quick transition and intelligent collective pressing.
- The Playing Style is underpinned by a strong 'team mentality', capitalizing on Australia's traditional strengths.

2) Coaching Philosophy & Approach

U8-U11: Skill Acquisition Phase

To prepare players for team football by developing the functional game skills:

- 1v1
- Running with the Ball
- 1st Touch
- Striking the ball



3) SAP League Training

- You are <u>required to attend both</u> <u>training sessions</u> and attend the game on Saturdays unless sick, injured or exceptional circumstances
- Training sessions are planned in advance so it is important that coaches know the number that will attend each session.
- Managers should use an app like
 Teamer to assist with communication regarding absence from training and games

6) SAP Plus Academy Program.



Peak Football and LFC have created a SAP PLUS program.

This model is to give players the opportunity to play more games without added time of training on top of the SAP program.

Players will have the option to join the winter season with Peak Football academy to play in the premier academy league every Sunday. This will give players a chance to play 24 games more in the winter season.

This will be optional and is not in anyway compulsory for the LFC SAP players.

7) Equipment

TOOTBALL CH

- Standard LFC Uniform: Shorts, Socks & Blue Shirt (numbered)
- LFC White Shirt: used for Away Games & and to be worn at Training (numbered same as Blue)
- LFC Tracksuit Top and Optional LFC Tracksuit Pants
- SAP Kit Bag included in U8 fees available for other age groups
 - Number allocation & clashes will be sorted out by Managers, existing players have priority
 - Dev Teams do not require numbered shirts only SAP players
 - Due to the amount of football, additional socks and shorts are a good idea
 - ➤ LFC Hoodie, LFC Beanie and skins are also useful for Kanga Cup
 - Coaching fees do not include uniform. All football attire is purchased from the uniform shop via our online store pickup is from the shop found downstairs at the clubhouse.

Note

Coaching fees are in addition to the player registration fee paid through FNSW play football (est \$300)



8) SAP League Costs (inc GST)

- LFC aims to be comparable with other community clubs with respect to coaching fees.
- We aim to recoup the investment made in coaching from our squads and from camps, spreading our overhead costs equitably. All payments go directly to the coaching office and do NOT fund any other club activities / teams.
- Our budget includes a 1% margin which covers contingency.
- Our LFC squads will train once per week on synthetic surfaces. All LFC coaches are paid an hourly rate based on their level of experience. NSFA charge SAP teams more to cover the better quality of grounds provided on game day.
- Costs are estimated and will be adjusted if there are any major (>\$30) variances in the coaching that was delivered.
- Payments will made in 3 instalments to spread the cost and align with the use of Active Kids vouchers.
- Non Refundable Deposit to secure a spot: Dec \$150 2nd Installment: due April \$250 Balance: July
- Cost per session remains unchanged (\$12.5 − \$13.75).
- Late payment fee any payment overdue after 60 days of the invoice being issued may incur a late payment fee of \$25 per payment.
